- Completed, signed **Entry Form** (one entry form per quilt) including Artist's Statement (see p.2)
  - **Quilt** measuring 16" x 16"
  - Non-refundable **entry fee**. Non AAQ members\* pay \$25 for the first quilt and \$10/ea for subsequent quilts. Alliance members pay \$5 per quilt. There are two payment options:
